Rule 8 of Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 provides as

under:-

"No promotion on regular basis shall be made to posts in Basic Pay Scales 17 to 22 and equivalent unless the concerned officer has completed such minimum length of service, attended such training and passed such departmental examination, as may be prescribed from time to time."

3. The exemption from mandatory training on the basis of age has been withdrawn with the approval of the competent authority. However, in order to ensure justice and fairness to the officers who were superannuating before the finalization of the ensuing training sessions, the exemption was extended till 31st July, 2016. Hence, the exemption from mandatory training is applicable **only** to the officers, who are superannuating before 31st July, 2016.

All the Ministries/Divisions are, therefore advised to note for compliance.
