

PREFACE

Pakistan Public Administration Research Centre (PPARC), Management Services Wing of the Establishment Division has been maintaining statistical record in respect of employees of the Federal Government since 1966, by conducting relevant census on periodical basis. The current volume of the Annual Statistical Bulletin of the Federal Government Employees is the 16th of this data series.

2. The analysis of data shows that size of Federal Government in respect of sanctioned and actual strength of its employees was 497,846 and 446,816 respectively. Out of total sanctioned strength 89.75% posts were filled-in, whereas 10.25% posts remained vacant in the various Ministries/ Divisions and organizations during the year 2012-13. The distribution of actual strength shows that a small share of 4.96% was occupied by the BPS 17-22 officers, whereas the large share of 95.04% was occupied by BPS 1-16 employees.

3. The current Annual Statistical Bulletin (2012-13) covers division/office-wise, domicile/gender-wise, and religion wise along with data of occupational groups sanctioned and actual strength in respect of all categories of Federal Government employees. The publication has been prepared on the basis of latest available data provided by various Ministries/Divisions/ Departments/ Offices of the Federal Government, on the prescribed format designed by PPARC.

4. I would like to thank, all focal persons of various Ministries/Divisions for their timely and valuable support and data which enabled the PPARC to complete the bulletin in time. The dedicated efforts made by PPARC in collection, compilation and analysis of data are also appreciated.
