OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - NOC FOR FILLING UP VACANT POSTS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EXPLOSIVES (DOE).

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division) letter. F.No.5(5)/2017-IID-Oil dated 31st March, 2021 on the subject noted above and to state that obtaining a prior NOC from this Division is mandatory before making specified kind of recruitment. Moreover, requisite staff with matching qualification, experience and grade is not available in the surplus pool for posting against reported vacant posts. Therefore, Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division) may fill 13 x vacant posts (01 x Assistant (BPS-15 (01 for Islamabad), 02 x Stenotypist (BPS-14) (01 for Quetta & 01 for Peshawar), 02 x UDC (BPS-11) (01 for Islamabad & 01 for Peshawar), 01 x LDC (BPS-09) (01 for Lahore), 02 x Driver (BPS-04) (01 for Lahore & 01 for Peshawar), 04 x Naib Qasid (BPS-01) (02 for Karachi, 01 for Peshawar & 01 for Quetta), 01 x Farash (BPS-01) (01 for Lahore) in Department of Explosives under that Division as mentioned in the letter under reference in accordance with the recruitment rules subject to completion of all the codal formalities and in line with the directions of this Division's Recruitment Policy dated 22.10.2014, as amended from time to time and mechanism dated 16-01-2015, as amended from time to time.

2. This NOC is valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of its issuance. However, according to para 1-(xiii) of recruitment policy guidelines dated 22-10-2014, as amended from time to time recruitment is required to be finalized **within 120 days** from the date of advertisement.

3. The advertisement to be published for recruitment may be forwarded by the concerned Ministry / Division directly to Press Information Department, Information & Broadcasting Division. However, the appointing authority of the concerned Ministry / Division / Department / Organization shall ensure completion of all procedural and codal requirements in letter & spirit in line with the Recruitment Policy while making recruitment and will be held responsible for illegality if any.
