NOMINATIONS OF BS-18 OR EQUIVALENT OFFICERS FOR 31<sup>ST</sup> MID CAREER MANAGEMENT COURSE (MCMC) AT NIMS KARACHI, LAHORE, PESHAWAR AND QUETTA FROM 01-02-2021 TO 09-04-2021

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Division's O.M of even number dated 09-12-2020, 25-01-2021, 26-01-2021,27-01-2021, 29-01-2021 and 02-02-2021 on the subject noted above and to say that the competent authority has been pleased to approve the additional nomination of Mr. Mir Hussain, Senior Court Associate, Officer Incharge, Supreme Court Branch Registry, Quetta for the forthcoming 31<sup>st</sup> Mid-Career Management Course (MCMC) at National Institute of Management (NIM), Quetta.

- 2. The course will be commencing from 01-02-2021. The nominated officers may report to NIM Quetta immediately. The above nomination is subject to provision of latest Annual Medical Examination Reports to be submitted to respective NIMs.
- 3. It is also pertinent to mention here that after the split of MCMC, into 10 weeks at NIM & 4 weeks at STI in accordance with the decision of Federal Cabinet, the course fee for each participant has been divided between the respective NIM and the Specialized Training Institutes, which amounts to Rs.160,714/- per participant, at NIMs, Karachi Lahore, Peshawar and Quetta (10 weeks) and Rs.64,286/- per participant (4 Weeks) for Specialized Training Institutes. The payment of course fee in respect of officers of occupational groups and Ex-cadre officers of all Ministries/ Divisions and their attached departments will be made by the Establishment Division while in case of officers of the Provincial Governments and autonomous bodies/organizations etc. nominated for the course shall be arranged by their respective departments/governments etc., and to this effect payment shall be remitted to the respective Director General, NIM, through bank draft/cross cheque/pay order at the time of joining the course by the officer concerned or as early as possible.
- 4. As per the Prime Minister's directive, issued vide this Division's DO letter No. 5/11/2000-T-II/T-I dated 10-06-2014 all Ministries/Divisions/ Departments are bound to relieve the officers on their selection for training course without fail. The Ministries/Divisions/ Departments shall make stop-gap arrangements, as the nominated officers are not required to attend their offices while undergoing training. Non-compliance of the directions of the Prime Minister shall tantamount

disciplinary proceedings under the Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973. Further, according to Rule 8 (b) of the Civil Servants Promotion (BPS-18 to BPS-21) Rules, 2019, if the officer fails thrice for any reason to attend the mandatory training will be recommended for supersession.
