OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - PROVISION OF NOC FOR ENROLMENT OF GB SCOUTS 116 WING- PROTECTION OF DIAMER BASHA DAM PROJECT (DMBDP).


The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Interior's O.M. No. 2/2/2008-GBS dated 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2021, on the subject noted above and to state that obtaining a prior NOC from this Division is mandatory before making prescribed kind of recruitment. Moreover, surplus employees are regular civil servants and cannot be placed in such organizations as per policy in vogue for absorption against the reported vacant posts. Therefore, Ministry of Interior may fill 825 x vacant posts of different cadres ranging from (BPS-02 to BPS-05) i.e. 643 x Sepoy General Duty (BPS-05), 138 x Sepoy (Technical Trade) (BPS- 5/7), & 44 x Civil/ Trademen (BPS-02 to 05) in 116 Wing of GB Scouts under M/o Interior as mentioned in the O.M. under reference in accordance with the approved recruitment rules of the posts subject to completion of all codal formalities and in line with the directions of this Division's Recruitment Policy dated 22-10-2014 as amended from time to time and mechanism dated 16-01-2015, amended from time to time.

2. This NOC is valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of its issuance. However, according to para 1-(xiii) of recruitment policy guidelines dated 22-10-2014, as amended from time to time recruitment is required to be finalized within 120 days from the date of advertisement.

3. The advertisement to be published for recruitment may be forwarded by the concerned Ministry/Division directly to Press Information Department, Information & Broadcasting Division. However, the appointing authority of the concerned Ministry/Division/Department/Organization shall ensure completion of all procedural and codal requirements in letter & spirit in line with the Recruitment Policy while making recruitment and will be held responsible for illegality if any.

4. This NOC is subject to provision of attested copies of duly notified Recruitment Rules for each of aforementioned vacancies in Para-1 above.

5. This Division's O.M. (NOC) dated 09<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 shall be treated as cancelled ab-initio.
