
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - RECRUITMENT AGAINST VACANT POSTS MEANT FOR DIRECT QUOTA IN VARIOUS FIELD FORMATIONS OF PAKISTAN CUSTOMS DEPARTMENT UNDER FEDERAL BOARD OF REVENUE.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Revenue Division (Federal Board of Revenue Islamabad's O.M. No. 2 (6)/2020-Customs-IV dated 19th, 20th May & 13th July, 2020 on the subject noted above and to state that obtaining a prior NOC from this Division is mandatory before making any kind of recruitment. Moreover, surplus employees with matching qualification, experience and grade are not available in surplus pool for posting against reported vacant posts. Therefore, Federal Board of revenue (FBR) may fill 422 x vacant posts of different cadres i.e. 13 x Stenotypist (BS-14), 09 x Data Entry Operator (BS-14), 07 x UDC (BS-11), 19 x LDC (BS-09), 02 x Wireless Operator (BS-09), 02 x Dog Handler (BS-07), 312 x Sepoy (BS-05), 17 x Driver (BS-04), 03 x Dispatch Rider (BS-04), 05 x Sanitary Worker (BS-01), 01 x Mali (BS-01) & 32 x Naib Qasid (BS-01) in various Field Formations of Pakistan Customs Department under Federal Board of Revenue as mentioned in the OM under reference in accordance with the approved recruitment rules of the posts subject to completion of all codal formalities and in line with the directions of this Division's Recruitment Policy dated 22-10-2014 as amended from time to time and mechanism dated 16-1-2015, 3-3-2015, 11-5-17 & 18-8-2017.

2. This NOC is valid for a period of six (06) months from 09-04-2020 to 08-10-2020. However, according to para 1-(xiii) of recruitment policy guidelines dated 22-10-2014, as amended on 21-9-2017, 27-12-2018 & 04-3-2019 recruitment is required to be finalized within 120 days from the date of advertisement. Whereas in line with para-1 (xvii) of the policy guidelines, advertisement to be published for recruitment may be submitted by the concerned Ministry/ Division/ Department/Organization direct to press advertisement (PID) for publication.

3. The advertisement to be published for recruitment may be forwarded by the concerned Ministry/Division directly to Press Information Department, Information & Broadcasting Division. However, the appointing authority of the concerned Ministry/Division/Department/Organization shall ensure completion of all procedural and codal requirements in letter & spirit in line with the Recruitment Policy while making recruitment and will be held responsible for illegality if any.
