- (2) Provided that if no suitable persons is available for promotion, the post or posts reserved for promotion shall be filed by initial appointment and failing that by transfer.
 - (3) Vacancies in posts in BPS-1 and 2 shall ordinarily be filled on local basis.
- (4) Upto 50 per cent of the vacancies in posts in BPS 1-4 shall be reserved ex-servicemen.

CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION

Promotion to the posts in column 2 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts specified, in column 3 on a regular basis and posse the qualifications and experience prescribed in column 4:-

QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

- 4. (1) A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the schedule notification.
- (2) Provided that the maximum age limit shall be relaxable in accordance with provisions of Initial Appointment to Civil Posts (Relaxation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1:

QUALIFICATION / CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

5. Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding under the Federal Government on a regular basis in the same Basic Pay Scale in whice post to be filled exists provided the person concerned possesses the qualificatic experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

- 6. Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment or transfer shall b probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and suffi reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, with rule 21 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer), Rules, 1973.
- 7. The other provisions specifically applicable to the employees holding posi-BPS-1 to 4 are given in the Appendix to this Notification.
- 8. These rules shall not apply to those Gevernment Organisations who have a own recrultment rules in respect of the posts included in this Notification. However, terms and conditions specifically applicable to the said employees as given in the Appel to these rules shall also be applicable to them.
- 9. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Divis (R-Wing) as contained in U.O No. F.9/4/90-R-5 dated 29th October, 1990.
