OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - ISSUANCE OF NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE FOR BY HQs FRONTIER CORPS BALOCHISTAN (SOUTH), TURBAT

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Interior's O.M. No. 3/2/2020-FC(B) South dated 23.10.2023, 27.10.2023 and 03.11.2023 on the subject noted above and to state that obtaining a prior NOC from this Division is mandatory before making prescribed kind of recruitment. Moreover, surplus employees are regular civil servants and cannot be placed in such organizations as per policy in vogue for absorption against the reported vacant posts. Therefore, Ministry of Interior may fill 11x vacant posts i.e. 07x Naib Subedar Education (BPS-11) and 04x Naib Khateeb (BPS-11) in HQs Frontier Corps Balochistan (South) Turbat, under that Ministry in accordance with the approved recruitment rules of the posts subject to completion of all codal formalities and in line with the directions of this Division's Recruitment Policy dated 22-10-2014, as amended from time to time, and mechanism dated 16-01-2015, amended from time to time.

2. Moreover, it is valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of its issuance. However, according to para 1-(xiii) of recruitment policy guidelines dated 22-10-2014, recruitment is required to be finalized within 120 days from the date of advertisement.

3. The advertisement to be published for recruitment may be forwarded by the concerned Ministry/Division directly to Press Information Department, Information & Broadcasting Division. However, the appointing authority of the concerned Ministry/Division/Department/ Organization shall ensure completion of all procedural and codal requirements in letter & spirit in line with the Recruitment Policy while making recruitment and will be held responsible for illegality if any.
