The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Interior's O.M. - 2. This NOC is valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of its issuance. However, according to para 1-(xiii) of recruitment policy guidelines dated 22-10-2014, as amended from time to time recruitment is required to be finalized within 120 days from the date of advertisement.
- 3. The advertisement to be published for recruitment may be forwarded by the concerned Ministry/Division directly to Press Information Department, Information & Broadcasting Division. However, the appointing authority of the concerned Ministry/Division/Department/Organization shall ensure completion of all procedural and codal requirements in letter & spirit in line with the Recruitment Policy while making recruitment and will be held responsible for illegality if any.
- 4. Further, this Division's O.M. of even number dated 11th September, 2023 on the subject noted above may be treated as cancelled / withdrawn ab-initio.
