Subject: - PROVISION OF NOC IN RESPECT OF 71 X VACANT POST IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES.

The undersigned is directed to refer to M/o Water Resources's O.M. No. 1(4)/2017-Admn dated 09th March, 2020 on the subject noted above and to state that obtaining NOC from this Division is mandatory before making any kind of recruitment. Moreover, requisite staff with matching qualification, experience and grade is not available in the surplus pool for posting against reported vacant posts Therefore to M/o Water Resources Division, may fill 21 x vacant posts (03 x Assistant (BPS-15), 10 x Stenotypist (BPS-14), 04 x UDC (BPS-11), 04 x LDC (BPS-09) in main Ministry as mentioned in the O.M. under reference, in accordance with the approved recruitment rules of the posts subject to completion of all codal formalities and in line with the directions of this Division's Recruitment Policy dated 22-10-2014 as amended from time to time and mechanism dated 16-01-2015, 03-03-2015, 11-05-2017, 18-8-2017

2. This NOC is valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of its issuance. However, according to para 1-(xiii) of recruitment policy guidelines dated 22-10-2014, as amended on 21-09-2017 & 04-03-2019 recruitment is required to be finalized within 120 days from the date of advertisement. Whereas in line with para-1 (xvii) of the policy guidelines, advertisement to be published for recruitment may be submitted by the concerned Ministry / Division / Department / Organization direct to Press Information Department (PID) for publication.

3. The advertisement to be published for recruitment may be forwarded by the concerned Ministry / Division directly to Press Information Department, Information & Broadcasting Division. However, the appointing authority of the concerned Ministry / Division / Department / Organization shall ensure completion of all procedural and codal requirements in letter & spirit in line with the Recruitment Policy while making recruitment and will be held responsible for illegality if any.
