OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: PROMOTION POLICY- GRANT OF EXEMPTION FROM MANDATORY TRAINING ON MEDICAL GROUNDS.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the instructions issued from time to time in respect of mandatory trainings and to say that with the approval of the Competent Authority, it has been decided that the Civil Servants in BS-18, BS-19 and BS-20, if declared medically unfit to undergo training/travel by the Central Medical Board and placed in "B Category" in line with para 4.17 of AGPE, 2004, henceforth shall not be nominated for mandatory training viz (a) Mid Career Management Course (MCMC) (b) Senior Management Course(SMC) (c) National Management Course (NMC) and National Defence Course (NDC) respectively. Their promotion will be deferred by the successive Departmental Selection Boards (DSBs) and Central Selection Boards (CSBs) till the attainment of exemption age as provided under the Policy.

2 The Ministries / Divisions are requested to bring the aforesaid decision of the Competent Authority to the notice of all concerned including Attached Departments/Sub-ordinate Offices under their administrative control for information and compliance.
